## **Challenge and Purpose**

This will provide them with an opportunity to take an active role within their local Lodge, as well as the various Lodges in their geographical area. By taking part in this program, they will be making themselves dedicated Ritualists; and, they will be making their Lodge and Freemasonry stronger.

### **Rules for Enrollment**

Applicant must be a Master Mason in Good Standing in a Mississippi Subordinate Lodge.

Enrollment Forms are available on the Grand Lodge website.

This program will be self-funded and the honorarium is deposited in the Program Fund to cover the basic cost of the Certificates, Jewels, printing and administration of the program.

### **Rules for Advancement**

Please remember – every time you perform the ritual, you're retracing a centuries-old tradition and making an impression on your candidate. Your effectiveness depends upon your ability as a ritualist.

The Applicant must perform the ritual parts from memory. Reading the part will not merit receiving credit for the part.

If this Certification is to be respected and sought after as a mark of accomplishment, we must insist that those who receive it pass a creditable examination.

Applicants will be held to the highest expectations and testing standards.

### **Issuance of Certification**

The Ritual Proficiency Certification herein specified shall be issued on the approval of the Grand Lecturer. Examination for the Certification shall be conducted by one of the Custodians of the Work, the Grand Lecturer, or his duly authorized representative.

The said Certification shall be issued in recognition of the Proficiency of the applicant but shall not authorize the holder thereof to conduct a School of Instruction or to serve as a District Deputy Grand Lecturer without specific authority to do so.
